

## G+PS Spring Graduate Awards Competition

A number of criteria-based awards for the 2023/24 academic year are available to **current and incoming graduate students at UBC**. Annual Value: ranges from \$150 to \$22,000

## **Important Notes**

- The Spring Awards competition is <u>not the same</u> as the **Forestry Internal Awards competition** (please see below).
- Course-based Master's students are not eligible for this particular competition.
- Please be fully aware of the competitive nature (campus-wide competition) and very specific criteria of these awards, before you invest time and effort in making application. *Do not apply* for a specific award unless you fully meeting the criteria. If it is a stretch, it is not worth it.
- Some transcripts can be obtained from Forestry Grad Program office. There is an earlier deadline for submitting transcript requests: May 2. Applications submitted without all required transcripts will not be considered.
- Double-check your time-in-program eligibility. Do not apply if you are over the minimum months of registration as you will not be considered.
- Priority will be given to eligible candidates who do not hold significant scholarship funding (i.e., \$16,000 or higher) for the 2023/24 academic year (September 2023 to August 2024)
