

## G+PS and timelines vs. deadlines

#### **Graduate programs are ultimately overseen by Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (G+PS)**

They have the final say on policies & deadlines

• General program targets (start to finish); candidacy, committee meetings, and general defense planning

G+PS **deadlines**: https://www.grad.ubc.ca/deadlines

 Specific to meeting program requirements within specific date and time (awards, defense milestones, program completion, graduation)

#### Mutual roles (PhD, MSc, MASc)

#### **Student responsibilities:**

- Be aware of milestones, timelines and deadlines
- Communicate your goals (early completion? Gaining as much experience as able?)
- Check in with your supervisor along the way

#### **Supervisor responsibilities:**

- Provide timely feedback & support for administrative tasks
- Be clear if/when a student's requested timeline isn't feasible
- Be available to the student, lead the committee

#### Major milestones MSc, MASc

- Establishing committee & first committee meeting
  - First meeting should take place within one year of starting program
- Completing coursework
- Thesis (18/<u>12</u>/6 credits)
- Defense (handled by Forestry grad office)

**Average completion time:** 2.75 years

**Program max:** 5 years


#### Major milestones PhD

- Establishing committee & first committee meeting
  - First meeting should take place within one year of starting program
- Advancing to candidacy (by 24 months, max 36 months)
  - Comprehensive Exam
  - Proposal approval
  - Coursework (if applicable)
- Dissertation
- External Examiner
- Defense (handled by G+PS)

**Average completion time:** 5 years

**Program max:** 6 years

Nominations for External Examiner form (August 31, 2023 Program End Date)	Friday, 14 April 2023	First of four deadlines for program completion by August 31, 2023.
Last day for G+PS approval of final master's theses and doctoral dissertations for May graduation	Friday, 21 April 2023	Last day for final master's theses and doctoral dissertations to be approved by the Faculty of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies for May 2023 graduation. Must be approved and accepted (not just submitted) by 4:00 pm Students are expected to submit 3-5 days before this approval deadline in order to have time for corrections.
Last Day for Acceptance of Final, Approved Doctoral Dissertation (Spring 2023 Graduation)	Friday, 21 April 2023	Fourth of four deadlines for Spring 2023 graduation.  GRADUATION DDL

## Program completion vs. Graduation

#### Program completion

- Fulfill all your program requirements (any time of year)
- Deadlines required if you want to meet end-of-term (no tuition next term)
- Tuition pro-rated if you complete early in the term (review UBC tuition refunds)
- Eligible for next graduation / conferral cycle (May or November)
- Letters of completion (not conferral) available on SISC (custom requests contact us)

#### Graduation

- Some graduation deadlines are quite strict
- Two graduation cycles May & November
- Must not be on financial hold to receive parchment



### General guidance

- Consider your goals
  - Are you wanting to complete ASAP? Gain experience (as a TA, doing field work, publications, attending conferences?)
- Work backwards from deadlines (graduation ceremonies, dissertation submission deadlines)
- Exceptions can require a bit of additional work
  - External committee members, Directed Studies courses
- Recognize changes to timelines may happen, and can be a good thing
- Changes to supervision & committee members can add time
- Administrative processes (e.g. confirming committee availability for meetings & defense) can take longer than you anticipate
- Reach out if you need help

#### DOCTORAL DEADLINES FOR AUGUST COMPLETION

**Jun 9** – Doctoral dissertation (and supporting documentation) submitted to Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies for external examination

Aug 4 - Last Day for Final Doctoral Oral Examination

Aug 31 – Acceptance of final, approved doctoral dissertation by Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies
