Stewardship Series: Food Forests

Join Stanley Park Ecology Society online as we welcome a panel of experts to discuss local food forest initiatives! A food forest or forest garden is a mixed canopy planting of edible native plants. Many have been established by Coast Salish Nations and other Indigenous communities in so-called BC with their continued stewardship to the present day.

The panel will share their experiences with creating and/or managing food forests in different spaces and contexts of Metro Vancouver [ancestral and stolen territories of the qićəÿ(Katzie), q̈wɑ:ńλ̄əń (Kwantlen), kwikwəλ̄əm (Kwikwetlem), máthxwi (Matsqui), xwməθkwəÿəm (Musqueam), qiqéyt (Qayqayt), se'mya'me (Semiahmoo), Skwxwú7mesh Úxwumixw (Squamish), scəẃaθən məsteyəxw (Tsawwassen) and səlilwətaɨ (Tsleil-Waututh) First Nations]. Student Scholarships from Nature Vancouver

Founded in 1918, as Vancouver Natural History Society, Nature Vancouver offers a variety of activities with a focus on nature education, and enjoyment and conservation of natural environment. We organize evening programs (from September to April), field trips (throughout the year), an annual summer camp and occasional workshops, and more.

Nature Vancouver awards annual scholarships of \$1000 each to an undergraduate and a graduate student. Applications for these scholarships can be submitted during the February to April period every year (submission time varies between years).
